The Sustainability Institute was founded in 1996 by the late Donella Meadows («Limits to Growth», «World3» for the Club of Rome) to apply systems thinking and organizational learning to economic, environmental and social challenges.

The mission of the «**Donella Meadows Leadership Fellows Program**» is to accelerate the shift to global sustainability by increasing the effectiveness of well-positioned sustainability leaders. Fellows learn to address social, economic and environmental issues at their root causes within their complex systems.

The ability to learn and act in complex systems is based on the three instruments «systems thinking», «reflective conversation» und «visioning». The training is in concurrence with the actual working environment of the fellows and enables them to effectively implement and spread the knowledge of and understanding for global economic, social and ecologic sustainability
